Foster Care Rates	We must ensure that providers caring for children and youth in our state's foster care system continue to receive the 5.4% Human Services COLA through the end of their fiscal year, June 30, 2023, and that is carried forward into the Maximum State Aid Rate (MSAR) base rate.
Human Services COLA	Support Senate and Assembly proposals to increase the Human Services COLA to 8.5% Modify to include prevention and children's health home care managers.
Child Welfare Prevention Funding	Support Senate and Assembly proposals to increase thestate reimbursement to counties to 65%.
Child Welfare Housing Subsidy	Support Assembly proposal to increase the subsidy to \$725 and to increase the upper age limit for foster youth leaving care to participate in the program. Modify to include annual increases tied to inflation.
